School Year 2018-2019

Kruse Way Rotary Club will offer one-year scholarships:

- Up to \$6,000 in scholarships awarded as follows:

\$2,000 awards for 4 Year Colleges

\$1,000 awards for 2 Year Colleges or Professional Programs

Eligibility:

- Graduating 2019 high school senior continuing his/her education at an accredited community college, university, or professional school
- Applicant's parent must be an employee of a business located within the Kruse Way corridor or neighborhoods located in zip code 97035 (Lake Oswego) OR
- Applicant must be a part-time employee of a business located within the Kruse Way corridor or neighborhoods located in zip code 97035 (Lake Oswego)
- Demonstrated academic achievement
- Demonstrated financial need
- Participation in extra-curricular activities
- Participation in community involvement

Student Application Requirements*:

1. Official Transcript
2. Copy of an acceptance letter from a two or four year college/university or professional school
3. Expected Family Contribution (EFC) amount from the Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
4. Completed financial summary
5. Completed scholarship application

***Applications are not considered complete without all the above information included.**

Application Submission:

- **Applications must be submitted no later than Friday, April 26, 2019**

Selection Criteria:

- Applicants will be interviewed by Kruse Way Rotarians in early May 2019
- Awards will be based upon the following criteria:
 - Financial Need 40%
 - Academic Achievement 30%
 - Extra-curricular 10%
 - Community Involvement 10%
 - Interview 10%
- Decisions of the selection committee are final
